Dear Mrs. Roosevelt:

I respectfully refer you to my letters to you of January 10th and March 2d, 1945, relative to my discharge for "Security Reasons" by Captain R. H. McCrary, U. S. Naval Air Station, Alameda, California.

I do not wish to appear insistent in this matter nor encroach upon your time, which we all know is much and rightly taken up with vastly more important affairs than my own.

If you feel agreeable to my request of January 10th and March 2d, 1945, I will appreciate it very much; and if you do not, I would like to know it so that I may then request each member of the California Delegation in Congress to assist me in placing this matter before the Commander in Chief for his perusal and disposition.

Mrs. Roosevelt there are some things no American will take lying down, and this is one of them.
