Dear Mrs. Roosevelt;

On Thursday, November 29th, the British Consul General, Mr. F. E. Evans, presented to the Executives' Association of Greater New York, Inc., a tribute to your late husband, Franklin Delano Roosevelt, from the Executives' Association of Great Britain Ltd., at which time the following resolution was passed;

"RESOLVED that the memorial tribute so graciously presented by the EXECUTIVES' ASSOCIATION OF GREAT BRITAIN LIMITED be referred to Mrs. Eleanor Roosevelt, widow of our late lamented President, for the purpose of placing this fitting tribute in the archives of the ROOSEVELT LIBRARY in HYDE PARK, NEW YORK, to perpetuate forever the brotherly feeling and respect existing between these two great Associations, and particularly in commemoration of the late President Roosevelt."

The memorial consisted of a limited edition of the London Times in which appeared an impressive tribute to our late President Franklin Delano Roosevelt, bound in red leather to protect and preserve this historical memorial for posterity. This was conveyed to us by Winston Churchill and through our State Department, so that it is distinctly an official communication.

It is our wish to invite you to one of our weekly luncheons, held every Thursday at the Astor Hotel, in order that we may have the pleasure of presenting the tribute to you. Please advise when you will be free to discuss this question.
