Dear Genia:

If as usual you are only working 24 hours a day, you can probably figure out how to squeeze in a little more activity - or even quite a bit.

I don't know how closely you have been touched by the Greek situation, but in this office we have it under our own eyes. The other day 12 little Greek boys, stowaways, came in on the "Marine Carp." Ages 11-15. Not a shoe or a coat amongst the lot. They were discovered 2 days out at sea. The Capt. kept them starving another day to make them tell who got them on board. But they insisted they got on all alone. Arrived here they were not allowed to land, but we got complete outfits of clothes for them and some extra for their families at home, and they were fed at least for 3 or 4 weeks. In all sorts of ways the Greek Democrats must figure out how to keep themselves and their children alive.

They have received no help from the present Government, and very little from UNERA. The official corruption is incredible. Freedom of the press is a joke. The one liberal paper has had 16 editors since the end of the war - all exiled or imprisoned on one excuse or another

I don't know how you feel about the Greek loan. But when you remember that the loan was originally refused by the Export Bank, specifically because of the corruption and inefficiency in Greek Government finances, it is pretty clear that the present loan is definitely a political weapon the tragic and horrifying spearhead of a new fascist imperialism, unforgiveably supported by America. How can we support King Paul, who was actually leader of the fascist youth? Would we support Baldur Schirach as Governor of Germany?..... If you have a little time or are in between campaigns, maybe you would give Ave. a hand with her work for the Greeks!

How are you anyway, and what's doing with the musical compositions of the family? Write me once in a while, and not one of those letters that sound like a competition to say ALL in 25 words.....Love
