It is planned that this collection shall be made a permanent institution-- that an International Shrine be instituted for the housing of these precious examples of the world's best work in literature. So we are inviting authors and editors everywhere to join this movement. So far our contacts have brought marvelous response, many writers contributing book length manuscripts.

Authors who die during their membership will be listed among our "Immortals." Of these, we already have a large group, among them being Hendrik Van Loon, Sir Arthur Eddington, Sir Arthur Quiller Couch, John Oxenham, Sir James Jeans, Cosmo Hamilton, Stephen Leacock, George Arliss, Charles M. Sheldon, David Grayson, Edwin Markham, Theodore Dreiser, Silas Bent, Booth Tarkington, Franz Werfel, Margaret Deland, Carrie Jacobs-Bond, not to mention many of the past century.

It is intended that this collection shall be offered to libraries and colleges as an exhibit. The first such exhibit will be at the St. Louis Public Library.

It is planned that Achievement Awards be made for commendable work of writers enrolling in the project. Gold and Silver medals are planned for outstanding literary merit. Publishers, also, will be given awards for outstanding quality in the production of books.

The Foundation will accept meritorious manuscripts, with a view to publication, on an attractive plan, and the Director will act as Agent or Literary Executor for authors who desire such a service.
