Dear Mrs. Roosevelt:

Yesterday, we held meetings of the Trustees and Directors of the Memorial Foundation at which were present Henry Morgenthau, Frank Walker, Sam Rosenman, Dave Niles, Franklin, Jr., and myself as well as Louis Brownlow and Grace Tully. We formed a new and smaller Executive Committee, of which I am Chairman, the other members being Henry, Frank, Sam and Franklin.
