Mr. BLOOM introduced the following bill; which was referred to the Committee on the Public Lands

A BILL

To establish the Castle Clinton National Monument, in the city of New York, and for other purposes.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*
3 That the Secretary of the Interior is authorized to accept,
4 on behalf of the United States, title to the site, comprising
5 approximately one acre and situated in Battery Park, New
6 York City, of the historic structure known as Castle Clinton,
7 together with such structure and any other improvement
8 on or appurtenant to such site. The title to land, interests
9 in land, and structures to be acquired pursuant to this Act
10 shall be acquired subject to the approval of the Secretary.

1 When title to such property is vested in the United States,
2 it shall constitute the Castle Clinton National Monument.

3 SEC. 2. The administration, protection, and develop-
4 ment of the Castle Clinton National Monument shall be
5 under the supervision of the Secretary of the Interior,
6 subject to the provisions of the Act entitled "An Act to
7 establish a National Park Service, and for other purposes",
8 approved August 25, 1916, as amended.
