It is unbelievable, but our daily mail consists of 500 to 700 letters, with from dollar bills pinned on to a contribution slip, up to \$500 and \$1,000 checks.

Mr. John T. Lewis has indicated a desire to continue the campaign until we reach the \$300,000 goal, which will bring us into the clear.

I know you will be interested in this, and that is why I am writing you in such detail.
