Dear Mr. President:

On December 6th Dr. A. S. W. Rosenbach is going to conduct a public auction sale of Americana, first editions, manuscripts, etc., for the benefit of Christian and Jewish refugees. This sale was announced some time before the recent disturbance in Germany.

The objects to be sold are being donated for that purpose. He has suggested that he would like to auction off a set of the Public Papers if you would be willing to autograph them for the purpose of this auction sale. I told him that I would be glad to donate the set of books if you thought that you could autograph them specifically for the sale at this auction. I should not think there would be any criticism of a set of an autographed set for the charitable purposes for which this auction is being held.

My only thought is that it might serve as a precedent for other charities. However, if the charity is a national one, perhaps that would not be an obstacle.

Would you please inform me whether you would be willing to do this, and if so I shall purchase a set for that purpose and send the first volume down to Warm Springs.
