Does it not seem to you amazing that the FBI should inform a man of this character of the contents of a personal letter which I had written to Mrs. Roosevelt? I think you will agree that action of this type makes it utterly impossible for you or myself to write confidential letters of this character to the President or to Mrs. Roosevelt, although in our judgment letters of this kind are strictly necessary.
