HIGH STRATEGY IS FATALLY DEFECTIVE. WHILE DESIRABILITY OF CON-
TINUING ENCOURAGE CHINESE TO MAINTAIN THEIR MORALE AND CONTINUE
INERT RESISTANCE IS UNQUESTIONED, THERE SHOULD BE NO ILLUSTONS
AS TO PRACTICAL ASPECTS OF ACTUAL SITUATION WHICH HAS BEEN RE-
PEATEDLY EMPHASISED IN REPORTS FROM ALL US GOVERNMENT OFFICIALS
CHUNGKING.

EVEN PRIOR FALL OF RANGOON THE LACK OF CHINESE OFFENSIVE
SPIRIT PLUS PHYSICAL AND POLITICAL DIFFICULTIES OF TRANSPORTATION
WERE CONTINUOUSLY REPORTED. PRESENT SITUATION IS FAR WORSE.

MEMORANDUM FOR THE PRESIDENT:

Attached is a radio which General Marshall sent to General Stilwell last night. General Stilwell's message No. 432, to which General Marshall refers, told of his difficulties with reference to commanding Chinese troops, described their incompetence and disregard of orders, and stated that Chinese let him down completely by a "chicken-hearted" imitation of an attack. He had induced the British to make a general attack by promising an attack by the Chinese.

Radio states that General Stilwell had gone to Chungking to have a "show-down" with the high command.

The President expressed to me in strong terms his pleasure at the frankness of your message 432 and the spirit it evidenced. He is particularly pleased with your prompt measure to rectify the situation. We are all hopeful that the arrangement outlined in your No. 448 will at least temporarily meet the situation. I am hopeful that you may be permitted to utilize some of your talented men for leadership and gradually develop a real striking force. There are no immediate prospects of dispatching an American Division to India.

Public reactions from press reports of your handling of the situation are extremely favorable and the Secretary of War and I are tremendously gratified by the progress you have made in a vital and extraordinarily difficult situation.

If you think wise please convey to General Alexander our appreciation of his cooperation with you in supply services, et cetera, for your Chinese troops.


