Netherlands Marine Brigade is subject. Reference is your message number S 71283 dated December 17, 44 to War Department.

1. Combined Chiefs of Staff on 11 October 1944 agreed:
 - A. United States Marine Corps initiate planning for the training and equipping of approximately 7000 men to be organized into Netherlands Marine Brigade.
 - B. United States Marine Corps assume responsibility for training of all Dutch personnel upon their arrival in United States.
2. To date, Dutch cadre of 59 officers and 295 enlisted men have completed training in United States. Navy Department is responsible for project and informs that additional arrivals are not expected in near future due to Dutch manpower limitations and for this reason project is practically at standstill. COMNAVEU may have additional information.
3. In addition to Netherlands Marine Brigade, Combined Chiefs of Staff have agreed to formation of 15 Dutch battalions for internal security in Netherlands East Indies, 24 battalions for maintaining order in Holland, and an Army Corps of three divisions to participate in war against Japan. Responsibility for formation and equipping these units rests with British. OCS agreed that formation of Dutch corps

should be undertaken in Europe.

4. Relative priority as between manpower requirements for Netherlands Marine Brigade and your requirements has not been established and is appropriately matter for decision by Combined Chiefs of Staff. Action being initiated to place the question of relative priority before the Combined Chiefs of Staff for decision, recommending that SCAEF be authorized to determine priorities for units to be formed from Dutch manpower liberated in his theater of operations.

5. Forwarding by air courier appropriate Combined Chiefs of Staff papers for your information.

RELATIONSHIP OF FORCES

The objective of every battle operation is dual--to destroy the enemy's means to resist and to break his will to resist. This dual objective can be achieved against a strong enemy only by a continuously-sustained massed explosive pressure. The certain weakening of the enemy is the resultant of such a massed employment of explosives which shocks, confuses, tires and demoralizes his potential to resist capitulation to occupying forces.

Three principles - FLEXIBILITY, CONCENTRATION, and SUSTAINMENT of EFFORT - govern the effective use of forces. Air power alone provides the requisite flexibility to develop a massed and sustained explosive effort against the enemy in any given locality. Air power, therefore, properly massed and sustained, must be used as the main pressure to weaken an enemy locally until his resisting power is forced to such a low effective state as will enable our ground forces (tanks, artillery infantry) to occupy his positions and seize his fighting means without prohibitive costs to our own fighting means.

Modern battle strategy and tactics derive success to the degree that air power, sustained and massed, is employed, soundly by theater, task force and air commanders. The decision to launch a joint operation and subsequent offensives in any theater of operations is greatly influenced by the quantity and quality of air power available. Experience dictates the requirement that the local air battle must be won first prior to the launching of a joint operation.

In modern battle operations the fighting by land elements of the task forces must be closely coordinated with the general air effort and with its day-to-day projected actions. The joint air-ground effort must be applied in such a manner as to inflict upon the enemy locally as well as generally the maximum possible weakening effect. In the application of this weakening effect air power plays the most influential part. So vital, in fact, is the air part in modern operations that the entrance of ground components into the battle must be timed on air capabilities.

Field Service Regulations FM 100-20, "Command and Employment of Air Power," sets forth the following doctrine for use of air forces: "The gaining of air superiority is the first requirement for the success of any major land operation. Air forces may be properly and profitably employed against enemy sea power, land power, and air power. However, land forces operating without air superiority must take such extensive security measures against hostile air attack that their mobility and ability to defeat the enemy land forces are greatly reduced. Therefore,

air forces must be employed primarily against the enemy's air forces until air superiority is obtained. In this way only can destructive and demoralizing air attacks against land forces be exploited to the fullest."

Complete control of the air can be gained and maintained only by total destruction of the enemy's aviation. Since this is seldom practicable, counter air force operations in the theater must be carried on continuously and intensively to gain and maintain air supremacy and to provide security from hostile air operations. The strategic air force is a powerful factor in assisting the tactical air force in the destruction of the hostile air power. It will often be desirable to use the strategic air force in the battle area. Decisive results in land operations can only be achieved by the development of the full power of the air in joint effort with the ground forces.

Too often in the past in the minds of military men has existed the idea that joint air-ground operations occurred only on the battlefield or in the immediate battle area. However, the destruction of the hostile air force in the air and at rest, the retardation of movement of hostile reserves, and the destruction of lines of communication are just as important a part of air-ground cooperation as is the attack of enemy units on the battlefield within sight of our own forces. Ground forces and air forces, in fact, constitute a combined striking force operating under separate commanders, but in furtherance of a common plan.

The role of the tactical air force is to plan and conduct joint operations with the ground forces. The tactical air force in a theater of operations has a high potential for sustaining a massed explosive effort. The advantage of massed air action and flexibility is lost when air units are parcelled out. The mission of the tactical air force to carry out its role in joint operations is divided into three priorities in the following order:

First priority: To establish and maintain air superiority. This is accomplished by the destruction of the enemy air forces in the air and on the ground, and of those installations which are necessary for air operations. While our air superiority is maintained, both the air forces and ground forces can fight the battle with little interference by the enemy air. Without this air supremacy, the initiative passes to the enemy.

Second priority: To prevent the movement of hostile troops and supplies into a theater of operations or within the theater. This phase is accomplished by the destruction of enemy shipping, port installations, communications, troop staging areas, large supply dumps and

transportation behind the actual battle zone. If the hostile force is denied food, ammunition and reinforcements, aggressive action on the part of our ground forces will cause him to retire and the objective will be gained.

Third priority: To participate in the joint effort of the air and ground forces to gain the objective in the immediate battle area. Massed air action concentrated for an extended period on an area to pave the way for an advance is the best type of third priority mission. In this last type of action the strategic air force is properly joined with the tactical air force.

Today the destructive and demoralizing blows that air power can deliver against a foe can be of themselves almost a decisive force. Together with explosive power delivered by artillery in all its forms, air power massed and sustained can be made to weaken an enemy locally as well as generally to the point just short of capitulation. / ?

The theater and air commanders in North Africa in 1942-43 learned the lessons - and applied them profitably - of massing air power and of sustaining air pressures; of concentrating the air effort and not employing it in "penny packets," of planning carefully decisive air operations instead of merely "administering" daily their total air effort in widely-dispersed missions.....These successful commanders kept before them the aim common to all forces--defeat of the enemy in the shortest possible time at minimum cost. The lessons learned earlier are reflected currently in successful allied air operations on the continent of Europe.

It may be repeated in summarization that to defeat the enemy in local contest, as well as in the entire war, it is necessary to bring about a great weakening of his forces, a thorough breaking of his means to resist. No other power except air power has the potential to inflict the degree of weakening on the enemy which will enable a decision to be wrung from him by troops with small arms. In modern battle operations the fighting of land elements and the general air effort in the theater must be closely coordinated. Air power, massed and sustained - and employed in timely fashion - establishes overall effective odds favorable to exploitation by other friendly forces who otherwise under aid of air superiority only are able to do little more than keep a defensive pressure upon the enemy. Every effort must be exerted to win the air battle first or to establish a degree of air superiority which will be favorable to the successful participation of other forces.

Generalissimo has asked that the matter of conducting Chinese training in India instead of in US be reconsidered. His argument is that training can be conducted more rapidly here thus getting the Chinese Air Force into the fight that much sooner, however it appears to us that it is impossible to supply a rapidly increasing Chinese Air Force in China in the near future precludes adoption of Asiatic training even if personnel and equipment could be made immediately available to this theater. We believe that a well trained and properly supplied Chinese Air Force a year from now will be more valuable to China and to the overall war effort than will a partially trained and supplied organization in the next few months. It is essential that this entire question be settled as long range planning is now being held up here. Your decision is needed.

Grateful that special service force is continuing in snow warfare training.

Impossible at the present juncture to define missions of this force in any but general terms but operations with plough type vehicles either seaborne or airborne are envisaged. (Reference 6066 dated February 211950Z from Agwar) with this object in view it would be appreciated if development of airborne vehicle with improved performance would be pressed on, also development of a heavier and improved type not transportable by air.

Mister Petter, now in Washington, know my views and can be contacted through combined operations liaison officer, joint staff mission. (To Marshall from Mountbatten signed Andrews).

Type of aircraft at present suitable limited to British Lancaster and American C. 54, neither of which would presumably be made available unless and until an operation of over-riding importance justifies this diversion of air efforts.






