IN THIS CONNECTION GIVE CONSIDERATION TO THE PROBABILITY THAT WE WILL LATER ON SEEK ARRANGEMENTS FOR FUTURE USE OF SOME PORT AS AN ADVANCED FLEET OPERATING BASE.

THIS IS A HICOM FROM COM 4TH FLEET. RADIO WASHINGTON PASS TO COMINCH AND CHIEF OF NAVAL OPERATIONS FOR ACTION AND TO CINCLANT FOR INFO.

YOUR 021630 AND 071225. I HAVE APPOINTED CAPTAIN MCCAULEY TO ASSIST UNITED STATES AMBASSADOR AND WILL KEEP IN CLOSE TOUCH MYSELF. I SUBMIT THAT RECIFE AIR BASE SHOULD BE INCLUDED IN OUR POSTWAR NAVAL REQUIREMENTS DUE TO LOGISTIC SUPPORT. AGAIN I SUGGEST THAT A PERSONAL LETTER TO VARGAS FROM PRESIDENT ROOSEVELT WILL CARRY MORE WEIGHT THAN ALL THE DIPLOMATIC CONVERSATIONS THAT CAN BE MUSTERED. THIS IS A ONE MAN GOVERNMENT. THE AMBASSADOR WILL ENCOUNTER MANY DIFFICULT HURDLES.

MISSION SOUTH COMPLETED. HAD 2 INTERESTING CONVERSATIONS WITH PRESIDENT VARGAS. BRAZIL HAS ALSO BEEN STIFFENED AND PLEASED OVER RESULTS IN LA PLATA AREA. BRAZ PRESIDENT EXPRESSED HIS DESIRE TO GO ALONG WITH PRESIDENT ROOSEVELT IN EVERYTHING. WORD TO VARGAS AT THIS TIME REGARDING PRESIDENT ROOSEVELT'S DESIRES FOR FUTURE OF AIRFIELDS IN BRAZIL WILL RECEIVE FAVORABLE ACTION. IF THESE FIELDS ARE NOT ADMINISTERED BY A JOINT BRAZ USA COMMISSION THEY WILL DETERIORATE AND OUR STAKE WILL BE LOST. I REPEAT THAT DOWN HERE IT'S PRESIDENT ROOSEVELT'S PERSONAL DESIRES THAT WILL BE GRANTED WITHOUT QUESTION OTHERWISE IT WILL BE A LATIN ARGUMENT WHICH IS NOT TO THE ADVANTAGE OF THE USA. OUR POSITION TODAY COULD NOT BE BETTER.
