Speech of Franklin D. Roosevelt at Concord, N.H., Oct. 26, 1914.

"DEMOCRATIC RALLY

Large crowd listens to the Several Speakers in Phenix Hall.

The one big Democratic Rally of the campaign was held in Phenix Hall, Monday night, and the attendance was large.

Hon. Nathaniel E. Martin, candidate for senator in this district presided, and the speakers of the evening were Franklin D. Roosevelt, assistant secretary of the navy, Robert C. Murchard of this city, candidate for county solicitor, Hon. Charles J. French, who aspires to a seat in Congress, and Hon. Raymond B. Stevens of Landoff, candidate for the United States senate.

The latter addressed a Democratic rally in Laconia earlier in the evening, and was late in reaching the hall."
