To the Editor of The World:

American imperialists and patriots are already renewing their cry for war upon Mexico, and soon a speech of war bell will be seized upon and "cleaning up Mexico" will attain the moral status of a crusade. If the people of this country had acquired the feeling that universal military training would give them the feeling that millions of trained potential soldiers awaited their call, they would find it less easy to listen to the war-reasoning dispositionately and less easy to consider it properly before decision.

The Spanish war, good or bad, shows how the press can make a war; and it won't be to distinguish compulsory training from service, for, as Gen. Wood himself has pointed out, once we are in war every man is always liable to service. Universal training, which we don't need for defense, would not be preparedness against war but merely preparatory to war.

Women Swimmers in Trials Here in July

The try-outs for the Women's American Olympic Swimming Team will take place at Manhattan Beach on July 15 and 16.

Through the good offices of the New York Women's S. A. the owners of the Manhattan Beach Bath house have at the disposal of the A. O. U. their new swimming pool, which it may be used to hold the competition, and help raise the sum needed to send one mermaid to the International meet at Antwerp.

It is the plan to run on the 100 metre swimming and springboard races, diving trials on one day, and the 300 metre swim and 100 yard race on the other.
