Robert Hannegan of Missouri be selected  
as the Chairman of the Democratic National  
Committee.

RESOLUTION #3

Resolved that a committee of this group, namely, Tom King of Wisconsin, David Kelly of North Dakota, Jake More of Iowa, Mrs. Marguerite Thompson of Colorado, Mrs. Ida McCabe Kayser of Minnesota representing this group shall immediately after the election of Robert Hannegan as Chairman call upon him and advise him that he will have the full and complete cooperation of this group and that they further convey to him the friendly attitude, high regard, and confidence we hold for Eugene Casey, and that they then suggest to the Chairman that it is the desire of this conference that Eugene Casey be given a Vice Chairmanship of the National Committee if such recognition is consistent with his feeling and that of the new Chairman and the President of the United States.
