In case of destruction or damages beyond a prompt and speedy repair, such damaged car to be replaced with a new car of the latest model available at the time. Your company further agrees to replace this car each year, or at the request of the Executive Office.

This arrangement is to be terminable any year as of the date of this letter by either your company or the Executive Office.

It is understood that no advertising use of this arrangement is to be made by yourselves or by any of your dealers or agents.

If this arrangement is in all respects entirely satisfactory to your company it will be appreciated if you will so indicate in writing at your earliest convenience.
