Now what I would like to do would be to apply for a refugee child from 12 - 16 yrs of age <sup>a girl</sup> that could go to school, help feel this entrapment in our home, enjoy the privileges of a home. I only ask that the child be one of our allied nations free from disease and mentally normal.

If there is any other information you desire please advise me or an application for me to fill out.
