Dear Dr. Eubar:

The President has referred to me your letter of July 26, 1944, concerning a sum of money contributed by the people of your district to be used for the relief of war refugee children.

I am enclosing for your information a copy of Executive Order No. 9417, creating the War Refugee Board, and outlining its duties and authority. As you will note therefrom, the Board was not set up to care for refugee children alone, but to carry out the policy of this Government to take all measures within its power to rescue the victims of enemy oppression who are in imminent danger of death, and otherwise to afford such victims all possible relief and assistance consistent with the successful prosecution of the war. Contributions to the Board may be sent to the United States Treasury Department with an explanation that such funds are to be used for War Refugee Board purposes.

In the event that you have another organization in mind, I suggest that you communicate with the President's War Relief Control Board, Washington Building, 1435 "Q" Street, N.W., Washington, 25, D. C., which can give you the names of organizations engaged in activities for the relief of refugee children.
