Dear Sir:

I read in the papers that the Red Cross has appealed to our government to admit more Jewish refugees to free ports in this country to save part of the remnant facing extinction in Hitler's death camps.

I think that the best and most advisable plan would be to establish free ports in Palestine.

However, we have just bought a tract of 550 acres near Pocono Summit, Pennsylvania at a point about equi-distant from Stroudsburg, Scranton and Wilks-Barre. We would be happy to have our tract used for the purpose of a free port. The property is served by a good macadam road, and telephone and electric service is available.

I further believe that any cost of installation of the camps and the maintenance of the refugees would be borne by the Jewish Welfare agencies so that no expense would be involved for our government.

I shall be glad to give any assistance in my power to further this project.

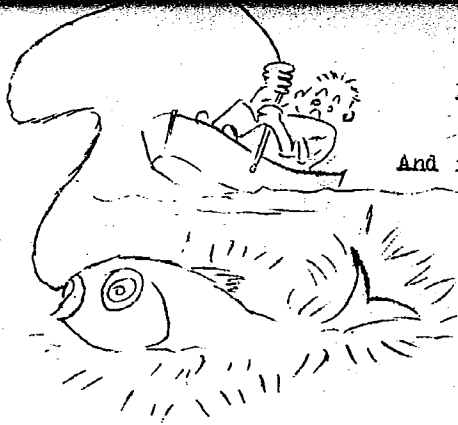
