I am pleased to advise you that the War Refugee Board's representative in Stockholm has requested us to inform you that your son, who was recently evacuated from Finland, is now safe in Stockholm.

We are also advised that your son is in need of funds, which are requested to be cabled through banking channels to Karl Avagen, 52, Stockholm. In order to effect such remittance, it will be necessary for you to obtain a Treasury Department license, application for which should be filed with the Federal Reserve Bank of San Francisco.
