Dear Mr. Pahle:

I am the editor of a Rabbinical monthly journal called HAPARDES. Within that journal is printed articles and advertisements for the campaign of the Vaad Hahatzala Emergency Committee which was organized at the start of World War II by the Union of Orthodox Rabbis of the United States and Canada whose office is at 132 Nassau Street in New York.

In their advertising they say that they are the largest as well as the only organization who devote their time and work to save Jewish people among which are prominent Rabbis and students. They say that they are connected with offices in Switzerland, Turkey, and Iran who had license from January 1 to July 15 of 1944 to send over \$400,000.00 to these various offices for rescuers, food and clothing.

I would like to know if you, as Executive Director of this War Refugee Board, know of all these deeds.
