Dear Miss Kunst:

Thank you for your communications of August 4 and 9, 1944, offering to provide a home for a refugee child from Hungary.

Your offer to care for one of these children is genuine evidence of the personal responsibility you feel for sharing the freedom which we Americans enjoy. However, until developments reach the point of actual immigration, plans cannot be made for the placing of individual children.

In the meantime, you may wish to write to Mr. Joseph E. Beck, National Refugee Service, 139 Centre Street, New York, New York, who may be in a position to be of assistance to you or to give you information as to the procedure to follow in this matter.
