MEMORANDUM FOR THE FILES

November 21, 1944

Subject: License to the American Jewish Joint Distribution Committee
to cable message to Dr. Emile Sommerstein, Polpress, Moscow

Miss Rodel of the War Refugee Board telephoned this Office this afternoon and requested that a license be issued immediately to the American Jewish Joint Distribution Committee, permitting it to send the following message to Dr. Emile Sommerstein, Polpress, Moscow:

"We acknowledge receipt of your three cables. Understand arrangements now being made Teheran for shipment 50 tons supplies to you. Grateful your efforts behalf Schwartz who now London and who informed your cables so that he applying for visa Soviet Embassy London".

Mr. Rueffer of the Censorship Relations Section, indicated that Censorship was holding up the transmission of this message on the grounds that a Treasury license was required for the reason that Censorship records indicate that the addressee is in Poland.
