There is transmitted herewith a copy of a ~~letter~~ dated February 21, 1944

from the Unitarian Service Committee dealing with remittance to Portugal for purchase of food parcels. Unitarian Service Committee desires to remit for the first nine months of 1944 up to an aggregate amount of \$9,000 to Dr. Robert C. Dexter, European Commissioner of the Unitarian Service Committee, Lisbon, to be used in Portugal for the purchase and dispatch of food packages to a selected group of individuals in France who are in danger of death, chosen by Dr. Rene Zimmer of Marseilles, a French citizen. The War Refugee Board recommends that an appropriate license be issued at once.

The War Refugee Board recommends that appropriate Treasury licenses and other necessary documents be issued permitting the execution of the project contemplated in the ~~letter~~ **application** described above.

This amount of \$9,000 to be used in Portugal for the purchase and dispatch of food packages to a selected group of individuals in France, chosen by Dr. Rene Zimmer, of Marseilles, French citizen. *who are in danger of death.*
