Would you kindly advise me about making out
an affidavit. The facts are the following:

My father and sister were interned by the
fascists in Italy for two years, because they were
Jewish refugees. On February 23 1944, I received a
letter from my sister and father, in which they told
me, that they escaped from an Internment Camp and
reached after a flight of six weeks the Allies. There
present address is Motel & Hannelore Dajcz JEWISH GROUP
NOI TRANSIT CAMP CAMP. Their Nationality is Polish.

Please advise me whether I can out an affidavit
for them or whether there is another chance of helping
them.
