Dear Mr. Dombroski:

I have your letter of March 5, 1945, concerning your desire to have your aunt and her daughter immigrate to the United States from Tanganyika, East Africa.

The Board was created solely for the purpose of rescuing and bringing relief to victims of enemy persecution in imminent danger of death. As Tanganyika is not in enemy territory and the lives of persons living there are not in danger from the enemy, the Board is unable to be of assistance to them.

I suggest that you communicate with the Visa Division of the Department of State concerning the procedure necessary in order to bring your aunt and cousin to this country.
