Reference is made to your conversation with Mr. Lesser regarding the plight of your parents in enemy-controlled territory. Please be advised that the Board, in collaboration with the Department of State, has developed a program calculated to bring relief to parents, spouses, and unmarried minor children of American citizens. While no assurances can be given as to the success of the plan, it is suggested that you fill out and execute the enclosed form, and file it with the Immigration and Naturalization Service, Department of Justice, Philadelphia, Pennsylvania, accompanied by a letter stating that you are filing such petition at the suggestion of the War Refugee Board.
