Dear Mr. Frankl:

Mr. Hirschmann has referred to me your letter of March 3, 1944, requesting the assistance of the War Refugee Board in rescuing your relatives from Theresienstadt.

I think you will understand that the task of the Board is so great that, of necessity, it cannot deal with problems limited to seeking out and rescuing specific individuals. I assure you we are doing everything in our power to rescue and save the victims of enemy oppression who are in imminent danger of death.

Persons in the United States seeking assistance for the rescue of specific individuals are being referred to private organizations. It is suggested that you may wish to refer your problem to the Central Council for Jewish Refugees, Woburn House, Upper Woburn Place, London, W. C. 1.

I have taken the liberty of forwarding to your brother-in-law in New York a copy of this letter and a list of several private organizations in the United States which I am advised may be in a position to be of some help, in the event that he may wish to take the matter up with one of them for you.


