Dear Sergeant Galewski:

This will acknowledge receipt of your letter of October 23, 1944.

There is no waiting list of refugees to be brought to the United States. The Board, however, in collaboration with the Department of State, has devised a special program calculated to aid certain persons, including the parents of American citizens, who are the victims of enemy persecution.

In order to bring your parents whatever benefits the program may offer, it is necessary that you fill out, execute, and file the enclosed form with the Immigration and Naturalization Service, Department of Justice, Philadelphia, Pennsylvania. You should advise them in filing such application that you are doing so at the suggestion of the War Refugee Board.
