Dear Mr. Grubert:

I have your letter of November 27, 1944, concerning your desire to secure information about the fate of your relatives in Poland.

I regret to advise you that the Board is not in a position to handle inquiries concerning specific individuals. I suggest, however, that you go to any Catholic rectory and request the priest to arrange for your inquiry to be sent through the Vatican message service. It is my understanding that the request will be directed through the Apostolic Delegate in Washington to the Vatican and that efforts will then be made to obtain information concerning your relatives through the facilities of the Nunciature and the Catholic clergy in Poland.
