Dear Mr. Kremer:

I have your letter of October 25, 1944, and sincerely appreciate your desire to secure information concerning your brothers and sisters in Debrecen, Hungary.

As you know, the Board is not in a position to handle inquiries concerning specific individuals. I suggest, however, that you go to any Catholic rectory and request the priest to arrange for your inquiry to be sent through the Vatican message service. It is my understanding that the request will be directed through the Apostolic Delegate in Washington to the Vatican and that efforts will then be made to obtain information concerning your relatives through the facilities of the Nunciature and the Catholic clergy in Hungary.
