Dear Sir:

This will acknowledge receipt of your letter of November 13, addressed to Mr. Lesser.

The Board was established by the President solely for the purpose of rescuing and bringing relief to victims of enemy persecution in imminent danger of death. Your cousin's parents, however, are in United Nations territory. The Board, therefore, is unable to be of any assistance in this matter.

If your cousin desires to apply for an immigration visa for his parents, he may do so in the usual way. The Visa Division of the Department of State can best advise you in this regard.
