Dear Mrs. Negro:

I have your letter of October 25, 1944, concerning your desire to have your sister come to the United States from Italy.

The Board was established solely for the purpose of rendering aid to victims of enemy persecution in imminent danger of death. Since your sister is in that portion of Italy which has been liberated from the enemy, I regret that the Board cannot be of assistance to her.

It is possible that a private organization may be able to be of some help to you in this matter, and I suggest that you may wish to refer your problem to any one of the agencies named in the enclosed list.
