Dear Miss Portuguese:

I have your communication of November 12, 1944, and appreciate your desire to secure information concerning your relatives in Lithuania.

I regret to advise you that the Board is not in a position to handle inquiries concerning specific individuals. I suggest, however, that you go to any Catholic rectory and request the priest to arrange for your inquiry to be sent through the Vatican message service. It is my understanding that the request will be directed through the Apostolic Delegate in Washington to the Vatican and that efforts will then be made to obtain information concerning your relatives through the facilities of the Nunciature and the Catholic clergy in Lithuania.
