Dear Mrs. Samuel:

I have your letter of August 1, 1944, requesting information concerning your parents.

The refugees who are being given temporary asylum in the United States reached the Emergency Refugee Shelter at Fort Ontario, Oswego, New York, on Saturday, August 5, 1944.

For information as to whether your parents are included in the group, and the arrangements made for visitors, I suggest that you communicate with Mr. Dillon Myer, Director, War Relocation Authority, Barr Building, Washington, D. C., which is the agency charged with the actual administration of the Shelter.
