Dear Mr. Zuhl:

Mr. Allan Tarshish has recently written to me concerning your desire to have your wife come to the United States from Romania.

The Board in collaboration with the Department of State has developed a program based upon the statutes relating to the issuance of non-quota and preference quota immigration visas, calculated to aid in the rescue of the spouses, minor children, and parents of American citizens and the wives and unmarried minor children of resident aliens who are in enemy occupied territory and subject to persecution. In view, however, of recent developments in and with respect to Romania, the Board does not feel that the application of such extraordinary measures to persons in Romania is either necessary or appropriate. For this reason, I suggest that you take this matter up with the State Department.
