Dear Mr. Rosenstone:

I have your letter of January 17, 1945, inquiring as to the relationship of the Emergency Committee to Save the Jewish People of Europe, Inc., with the War Refugee Board, and as to how much has been accomplished toward saving the Jews of Europe.

The War Refugee Board is a Government agency which is not directly affiliated with any private group. However, in the development and execution of its programs for the rescue and relief of the victims of enemy persecution, it has received the suggestions, the cooperation, and the assistance of a number of private organizations, among them the Emergency Committee to Save the Jewish People.

To accomplish the task assigned to it, the Board has pursued a variety of programs which have met with varying degrees of success. Accurate and coordinated statistics as to the numbers who have been rescued through these efforts are not yet available. We do know, however, that thousands have been enabled to escape from enemy areas to places of safety and that many more have benefited from indirect measures and from programs directed to obtaining protection and better treatment for those for whom escape has not been possible. The Board is doing and will continue to do everything in its power to save as many of these unfortunate people as possible.
