Dear Sirs:

We are wondering if some of the European refugees might not be desirous of going on a farm to secure livelihood. We have two farms which we are anxious to sell or might rent. They consist of 337a together and are located in south-eastern Ohio, Morgan Co., $\frac{3}{4}$ mi. off of paved highway 77 from Janesville to Manetta, near Heelysville.

One farm is hilly one consists of much valley land suitable for crop raising. They are run down because of tenant occupancy but could soon be brought back. There is a frame dwelling house of seven rooms, a

large barn for hay, a sheep barn, coal house, garage, chicken house etc.

The principal industries in this part of the state are dairying, cattle, sheep and poultry raising, also it is quite profitable to raise vegetables for the easily accessible eastern markets.

We are asking \$5000 for the two farms or \$4000 for either. If you can give us any suggestions or information we shall certainly appreciate it. We thought some refugees might be able to buy. Thank you very much.
