

May God Spare you for a long time to come so that you can continue to lead us out of this chaos, which has plunged us back into the medieval ages.

**Prominent Insurance  
Agent Is Honored**

The Grand Jurors Association of the Bronx will install on Thursday evening, January 13, its newly elected president, Adolf H. Sternberg, who was recently elected. Mr. Sternberg is widely known throughout the city especially in the Bronx where he has been active in Jewish, philanthropic and civic activities. Mr. Sternberg was the first president of the Bronx Insurance Men's Association, serving for two years. He is now chairman of the legislative committee. He also serves as chairman of the insurance committee of the Bronx Chamber of Commerce and is a member of the joint committee of the five brokers associations.

He is a member of the Federation of Jewish Charities, on the board of the Joint Distribution Committee and of the American Jewish Congress. He is assistant program director for the war finance committee of the Treasury Department and a member of the Bronx Inter Faith Council.
