Mr. President:

The State Board of the Pennsylvania Branch of the Women's International League for Peace and Freedom, meeting in Altoona, Pennsylvania, on February 22nd, voted unanimously to thank you for your prompt appointment of the Emergency Commission for Jewish Refugees provided in Senate Resolution 203.

The Board sincerely hopes that the Commission will start its work without delay and will rapidly find means to rescue the remaining Jewish survivors of Axis barbarity, who are fast dying from want, exposure and direct persecution.

We respectfully urge you to do all in your power to extend the spirit of this work throughout our own country in order to arrest the tide of irrational anti-Semitism and other racial enmities which are spreading here at home. Tensions are growing so rapidly and extensively that practically any minority may be subjected to violence in one part of the country or another, and the sense of growing insecurity may have extremely unfortunate results during the final period of the war and the post war years.
