Dear Mr. Schmidt:

On August 24, 1944 we received your communication (75957) together with Treasury licenses Nos. W-2275 and W-2276 for transmitting funds to Palestine and Switzerland. One of our recipients in Switzerland was Mr. Marc Jarblum.

As you are no doubt aware, we have already sent part of this money to Mr. Jarblum. Since then, however, Mr. Jarblum has returned to Paris, where he originally came from. He is conducting his work of rescue and help of refugees from his new center in Paris.

We would therefore like your permission to send \$6000 of the balance of the money we are permitted to send, to Mr. Jarblum in Paris, instead of Switzerland. Mr. Jarblum's address now is 45 Rue Claude Bernarde, Paris, France.

Thank you for your past assistance. We hope you will grant our request and await an early reply.

MEMORANDUM FOR THE FILES

November 23, 1944

Subject: Letter No. 78963 from Poale Zion Organization, New York City, requesting license to remit \$6,000 to Mr. Marc Jarblum in Paris, France.

This case was discussed with Miss Hodel of the War Refugee Board, who indicated that the Board perceived no objections to the remittance in question.

In a telephone conversation this morning, Mr. David Wertheim, Secretary of the Poale Zion Organization, stated that Mr. Jarblum would use the funds to be remitted under the requested licenses for the relief in France of various members of the underground who had been active in rescue work during the German occupation of France. These funds would also be used toward assisting these persons in reaching Palestine.
