It is requested that you inform Dr. B. Tochlenov of the International Red Cross in Geneva, and Dr. L. Hersh, Professor at the University of Geneva, that the Treasury Department has issued license No. W-2186 to the Jewish Labor Committee giving it authority to carry on communications with enemy or enemy-occupied territory for the purpose of carrying on in such territory relief and evacuation operations. This license is in all respects identical with those issued to the World Jewish Congress, the Joint Distribution Committee, and the Union of Orthodox Rabbis, the substance of which licenses are contained in Department's telegrams of January 20, January 5, and January 22, Nos. 197, 59, and 229 respectively, and further referred to in the Department's cables of February 2 and 3, 1944, Nos. 541 and 411, except that the Jewish Labor Committee's license specifies in paragraph B that the total amount authorized for the half year beginning January 1, 1944 shall not exceed \$14,500 Swiss francs or the dollar equivalent.

The operation covered by this license has been approved by the Department, the Treasury, and the War Refugee Board.
