Reference is made to Department's telegrem 404 dated February 26 with legard to proposal to move Spanish Republican refuge a from North Africa to Rexico.

an officer of the Embassy discussed this matter on two occasions since receipt of the Department's telegram, with Lie, Tello, Official Neyer of the Mexican Foreign Office, and with another official there, Lie. Tello stated that the Mexican-Spanish Countries on has agreed to accept these 1,600 refugees, and that the matter is now in the hands of Gobernscion for final approval. The Ministry for Foreign Affairs requested Cobernscion last week to expedite its action, and Lie, Tello expects a definite reply within a few days.

The Oficial Mayor mentioned that the Gobernacion member of the Mexican-Spanish Convission suggested that the refugees, upon arrival in the United States, be visced individually by Mexican consular officials. The Foreign Office, however, has decided that this would be impractical, and will arrange for the issuance of a group visa. Lie. Tello hopes that the ship or chips bringing the refugees disembark them at an American port as near as possible to the Mexican border, and he said that the Mexican Government would be agreeable to disembarkation at Tampico, if this should be feasible.

MEMORANDUM FOR THE FILES
