- 28 - 31 Investigative Case Files, 1934-1945: Investigations of individuals resulting from the receipt of letters containing threats or implied threats or resulting from the appearances of persons with real or imagined grievances at the White House gates. This is a random sample (about two feet) of a larger number of files (about 112 feet). Only this random sample has been reviewed and opened for research in "sanitized" form.
