MEMORANDUM BY THE PRESIDENT

The President has approved Joint Resolution making appropriations for the Federal Communications Commission, etc. This Joint Resolution also sets forward ^{the date from} ~~the date~~ on which all Government employees shall receive full salary (from July 1, 1935 to April 1, 1935.) This decision of the Congress will, it is estimated, constitute an additional charge on the Government of \$16,000,000. It should be noted that this sum was not contained in the Budget estimates and that consideration should properly be given to methods by which Government revenues can be increased to meet this and any other new appropriations which tend to throw the regular Budget out of balance.
